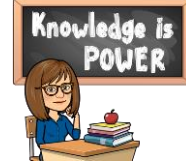

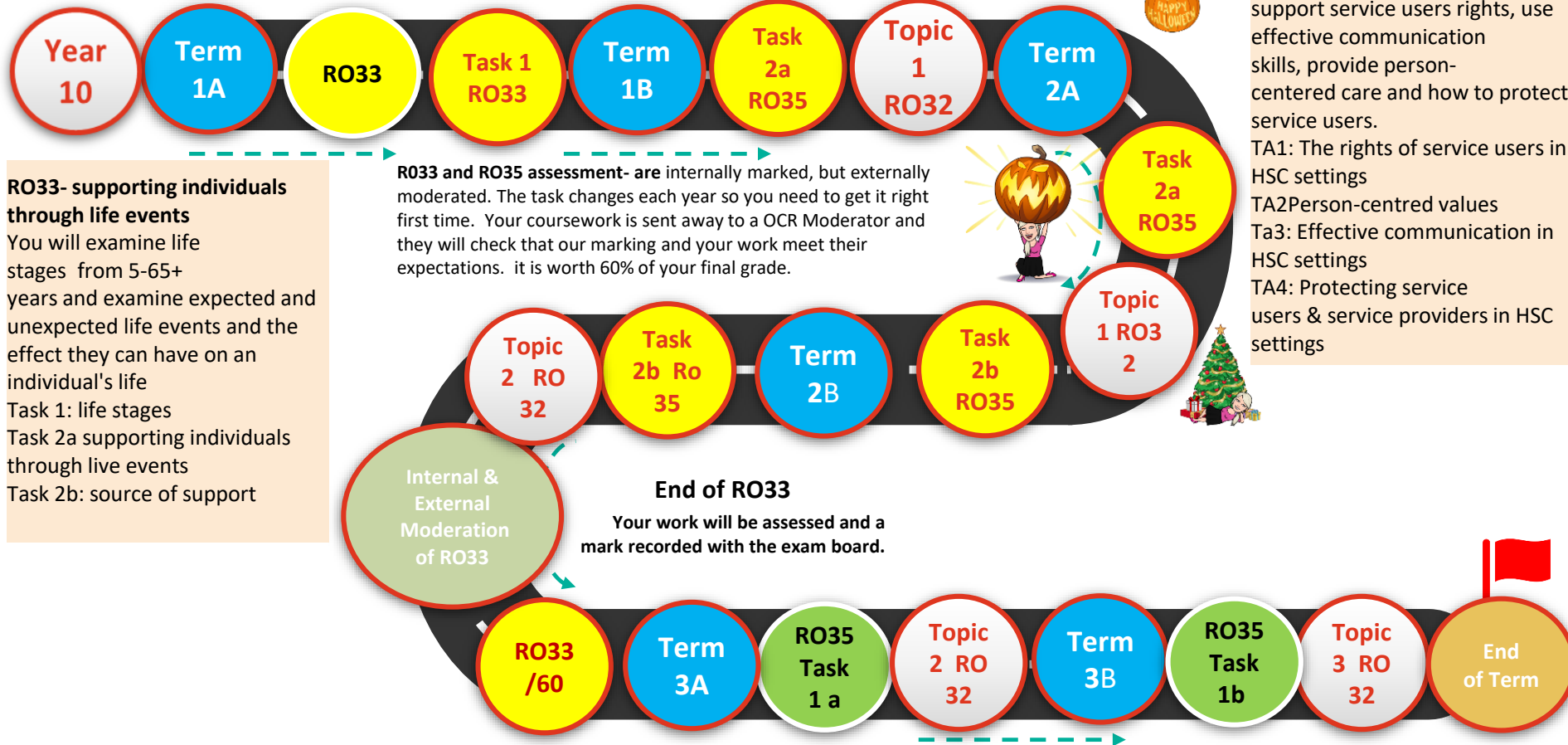


The Journey Starts

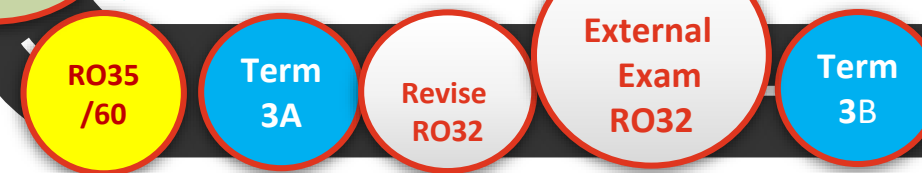
RO35- Health promotion campaigns
